



## Requirements for New Members (Field Team)

- Submit completed SSAR Application
- Submit completed Pinal County Sheriff Background Check, and fingerprinting
- Submit completed Liability Release
- Read "SSAR By-Laws" and review with board member
- Complete "Wilderness First Aid" training
- Obtain and keep current CPR certification
- Complete "Arizona Basic Search and Rescue Academy"
- Complete "Blood Born Pathogens" training
- Current Tetanus inoculation
- Complete "NASAR Tech II training
- Complete "Ropes 1" training.
- Procure a "24 Hour Rescue Pack" per NASAR Tech II guidelines
- Attend 1 annual "Arizona State SAR"
- Successfully complete physical fitness test
  - 10 miles in 5 hours with 35lbs pack (Bluff Springs – Dutchman's loop)
  - 3 miles in 45 minutes on flat ground with 35lbs pack
  - Summit Silly Mountain and return in 30 minutes with 35lbs pack
- Complete "Base Camp Orientation"
  - Team radio familiarization
  - ICS forms and paperwork
  - Familiarity with team trailer for equipment and supplies
  - Handling external influences
  - Base camp operations
  - Setting up a LZ
  - Helicopter Safety
- Payment of annual dues - \$40
- Purchase approved SSAR group pager or other text device.
- Purchase team uniform (yellow / orange t-shirt and tan full length pants)
- Meet with board for introductions and receive SSAR number

### Recommended:

- Wilderness First Responder (WFR) class
- Phoenix Orienteering "Land Navigation" class
- Arizona Basic Search and Rescue Academy if not attended in five years
- Inoculation for Hepatitis A and B
